

## YESHUA & HIS SECOND COMING

Heavenly Father,

I thank You that Yeshua is coming again. He comes with clouds and every eye shall see Him, even those who pierced Him. I remember Your Word as it says,

*“And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and they shall look upon me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourns for his only son, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn.”*

I pray, therefore, for each one, including myself, that we anticipate His coming, thus it will not come unexpectedly. I thank You, Father, that we are children of light and of the day. We are not of the night, nor of darkness. By Your mercy and grace, we don’t succumb to a spirit of slumber, but rather we are fully awake and remain completely alert. We are Your watchman on the wall, doing the bidding of our Father, in heaven. Each true believer is, therefore, clearheaded and wise in this matter of watching, as well as all other matters pertaining to the Kingdom of God. I rejoice Lord, that You have not appointed us to wrath, but we obtained mercy through salvation, brought about in Yeshua Ha' Maschiach. He died for us, so whether we fall asleep and are laid in the ground before He returns, or if we are alive when He comes back, we shall live with Him, forever. This is our comfort and our hope, with which I gladly encourage and edify my fellow brothers and sisters of this precious faith. With this truth, as with all other truths from the Word of God, I exhort all. I trust that, by the truth and the power of Your Holy Spirit, none of us will be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin but rather, each one of us will live in righteousness, fulfilling the will of the Lord and doing the work of the Kingdom.

In these days, especially, as we look at the signs around us, and by the witness of Your Holy Spirit, we know that Yeshua's coming is so very near. Father, therefore, I do not forsake the gathering of believers but regularly meet with them. Wherever and whenever I meet with them, I reassure them of Your faithfulness, of Your love, mercy and power. With Your Holy Spirit's strength, love and ability released to me, I speak and adhere to Your Word. I follow after the things which make peace, things which edify one another. I am zealous for spiritual gifts, which I use to fortify others. I truly seek Your face, on behalf of all believers, asking You to release to them all the help they need, so each one may excel in their faith to the edifying of the entire Body of Messiah.

As long as it is day, I will say, constantly and continually what the Spirit and the Bride say, "Come". *I say also, let even the ones who hear, say, "Come". Let all who are thirsty say "Come". Whosoever will come, let them come freely and partake of the waters of life".* I also say to all, "Look up, for your redemption draws near!"
